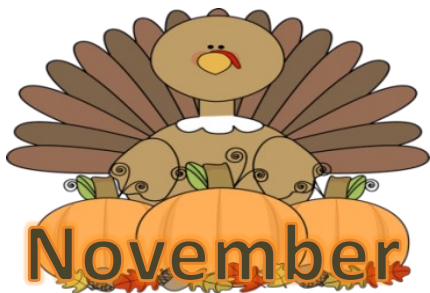

Happy November! Thank you to all that wished me a Happy 50th Birthday! I am so lucky to be at Hoover. Our families, students and staff rock!

I want to take this time to answer a question that comes up often. That question is, "What is Hoover's safety plan?" **Here's the answer...** We have drills that we practice regularly: fire, medical (CPR, Epi-pen etc.) and other protective drills. We also have a safe evacuation site. We do not publish or share some of our safety drills or site due to the fact that we don't want all our procedures to be public. Our doors are locked every day after students arrive and that is why we ask you to buzz into the office and check in. We also have a school safety team made up of teachers and staff and we review our procedures often. Finally, we have District and State level training that we are required to attend. Please know that the safety of your children is our number one priority. Don't hesitate to contact me at any time if you have questions.

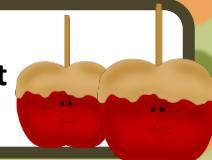
